CLASS 1 LEAD REIN/ASSISTED WORKING HUNTER PONY – 40cm Max

For mares or geldings/any breed/type, 4 years old or over not exceeding 153cms. No age limit for riders. This class is intended for novice/nervous riders not confident to attempt a course on their own. Combinations in this class may only enter additional classes HC.

CLASS 2 BEGINNERS WORKING HUNTER PONY – 50cm Max

For mares or geldings/any breed/type under 153cm starting in their first year of working hunter who have not won an open WH class. No age limit for riders.

CLASS 3 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY – 60cm Max

For mares or geldings/any breed/type under 153cm. Pony/Rider combination not to have won more than one 1st in any WH pony class. No age limit for riders.

CLASS 4 SMALL OPEN WORKING HUNTER PONY – 75cm Max

For mares or geldings/any breed/type under 153cm. No age limit for riders.

CLASS 5 BLAIR CASTLE OPEN WORKING HUNTER PONY CHAMPIONSHIPS

There are three classes, in line with BSPS rules. The series is run under **BSPS rules**, but is not affiliated to the BSPS.

- 5.1 WHP not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Maximum height of fences 90cm.
- 5.2 WHP exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 143cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Maximum height of fences 1m.
- 5.3 WHP exceeding 143cms and not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Maximum height of fences 1.05m.

In each qualifying class, the first four ponies will qualify for Blair, with qualification passing down the line to 6th place if ponies placed in the top 4 have already qualified.

WORKING HUNTER PONY CHAMPIONSHIP

1ST & 2ND from each WHP Class go forward for championship

CLASS 6 BEGINNERS WORKING HUNTER HORSE – Approx 60cm

Not Before 1pm

For horses exceeding 153cm starting in their first year of working hunter who have

not won an open WH class.

CLASS 7 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER HORSE – Approx 70cm

For horses exceeding 153cm. Horse/Rider combination not to have won more than one 1st in any WH horse class.

CLASS 8 INTERMEDIATE WORKING HUNTER HORSE – Approx 80cm

For horses exceeding 153cm.

CLASS 9 SMALL OPEN WORKING HUNTER HORSE – Approx 90cm

For horses exceeding 153cm

CLASS 10 Courier / BHS Scotland Riding Club Working Hunter Series 2015

Maximum height 3ft 3ins (1.00m), maximum spread 3ft 6ins (1.05m), except open ditch and water.

Qualification: The first THREE qualify for the final, even if they did not jump clear. If one of the first three has already qualified the qualifying card can be passed down to fourth place provided he 4th placed rider jumped clear.

CLASS 11 Stewarts Building Services / BHS Scotland Working Hunter Series 2015

Maximum height 3ft 6ins (1.05m), maximum spread 3ft 9ins (1.12m), except open ditch and water.

Qualification: The first THREE qualify for the final, even if they did not jump clear. If one of the first three has already qualified the qualifying card can be passed down to fourth place provided the 4th placed rider jumped clear.

WORKING HUNTER HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP

1ST & 2ND from each WH Class go forward for championship

Horses & Ponies should not be entered into more than two consecutive working hunter classes.

All classes will be judged on jumping ability, manners and ride/show.
