BSPS Winter Championship Qualification

The following Classes (4-6, 8-9) are qualifiers for the BSPS Winter Championships Show. The 1st, 2nd & 3rd prizewinners will qualify in the novice Classes and in the MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE CLASSES the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th prizewinners will qualify. In the Open (Restricted) Classes the three highest placed Restricted animals in each class will qualify and in the MIXED HEIGHT OPEN (RESTRICTED) CLASSES the four highest placed Restricted animals will qualify, (**riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband**). 1st – 4th prizewinners in the Open (Restricted) classes qualify for the Premier League at the Summer Championship Show. The First Prizewinner for each of the Open (Restricted) classes will qualify for the BSPS "Winter Winners" Competition to be held at the BSPS Winter Championship Show, Cards will be awarded. Animals must be registered before the date of the show at which they qualify for the Winter Championships and must be ridden by BSPS Members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies, providing they have a valid JMB Certificate (ex Heritage Classes) before the date of the Championship they qualify for.

Please note there is now no need to qualify for the Open Classes at the Winter Championships

AGES FOR RIDERS OF STALLIONS. Riders must be 12 years old or over on 1st January in the current year to ride any pony stallion not exceeding 138cms or Small Breed M & M stallions ie. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A & B. Riders must be 14 years old or over on 1st January in the current year to ride any stallions exceeding 138cms or Large Breed M & M stallions ie. Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D.

RULES FOR RESTRICTED QUALIFICATION

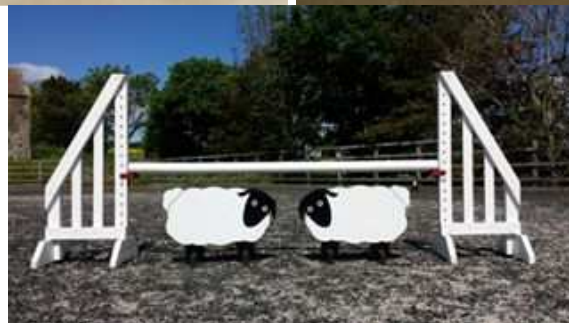
- Animals eligible for the Restricted WHP/WH qualification must NOT have been placed 1st – 8th at the RIHS or HOYS in the WHP/WH classes in 2014/2015/2016.
- Animals eligible for the Restricted Nursery Stakes qualification must NOT have been placed 1st – 8th at the RIHS in the Nursery Stakes class in 2014/2015/2016.
- Animals eligible for the Restricted Heritage WHP qualification must NOT have been placed 1st – 8th at the RIHS or HOYS in the Mountain & Moorland WHP classes in 2014/2015/2016.

(Riders on Restricted eligible animals MUST wear an armband).

In the Event of Bad Weather

We are aware of the vagaries of the Scottish weather but are also mindful of the need for Scottish competitors to qualify for the Winter Champs and to get young horses and ponies out for some ring experience. We will therefore endeavour to run our shows regardless of weather and make amendments to cope on the day. However, competitors should phone the secretary/organiser if they are in any doubt of a show going ahead.

Qualification will be from placings, no qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, and no qualification can go down the line.

TRAINING WORKING HUNTER CLASS

Here is an opportunity to jump the height of course of your choice regardless of winnings/status of your horse or pony. Help and advice will be available to anyone who may need it, or you are more than welcome to take your trainer/helper/parent in the ring. You may compete as many times as you would like.

FUN, WARM UP, PRACTICE, LEARN!!



- Class 1 **TRAINING CLASS, will start as small as required and go up in intervals**, for any pony or horse, any height, plaited or natural. All those jumping a clear round will receive a rosette. Subject to time, a horse/pony can compete as many times as wished at each height.
(a further Training session will be held between the Pony & Horse classes but only if time permits)

WORKING HUNTER PONY CLASSES To Commence not before 10.30am

- Class 2 **LEAD REIN/ASSISTED WHP**, mares or geldings , 4 years old or over not exceeding 148cms. No age limit for riders. This class is intended for novice/nervous riders not confident to attempt a course on their own. Pony/rider combinations entered in this class will not be eligible to compete in any other class (other than clear round/training class). Maximum height of fences 40cm and will be mainly poles with no 'scarey' fillers.
This Class is NOT affiliated to BSPS
All riders who complete will receive a rosette
- Class 3 **BSPS OPEN CRADLE STAKES PONY**, mares or geldings , 4 years old or over not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
(Please note this class is NOT a qualifier for the BSPS Winter Championships – as no qualification is required for this class)
- Class 4 **BSPS WINTER OPEN (RESTRICTED) NURSERY STAKES PONY**, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. *A Rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Novice Pony in this class.*
(Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband)

MINI WHP CHAMPIONSHIP

open to the 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 3 & 4

- Class 5 **BSPS WINTER NOVICE MIXED HEIGHT WHP/WH**, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 158cms. Competitors must jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of pony that they ride. (133cms/14yrs; 143cms/17yrs; 153cms/20yrs; 158cms/25yrs. Riders may ride



more than one animal providing they are of different heights. Animals exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 153cms must declare before the class commences whether they wish to compete in the 153cm or Intermediate section. **The 133cm ponies will jump first.**

This class will be split if there are sufficient entries

Class 6 **BSPS WINTER OPEN (RESTRICTED) WHP/WH**, mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 158cms. Competitors must jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of pony that they ride. (133cms/14yrs; 143cms/17yrs; 153cms/20yrs; 158cms/25yrs. Riders may ride more than one animal providing they are of different heights. Animals exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 153cms must declare before the class commences whether they wish to compete in the 153cm or Intermediate section. **The 158cm ponies will jump first.**

This class will be split if there are sufficient entries

(Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband)

WHP CHAMPIONSHIP

open to the 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 5 & 6



HERITAGE WHP CLASSES

Class 7 **BSPS HERITAGE M&M NURSERY STAKES**. Registered Pure-Bred Ponies 4 years old or over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 13th birthday before 1st January in the current year. *(Please note this class is **NOT** a qualifier for the BSPS Winter Championships – as no qualification is required for this class)*

Class 8 **BSPS WINTER NOVICE HERITAGE MIXED HEIGHT M&M WHP**. Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, Registered Pure Bred ponies. Riders any age. In a mixed height class, riders may ride more than one animal providing they are of different heights. Animals must jump in their correct height section. **Small height will jump first.** *This class will be split if there are sufficient entries*

Class 9 **BSPS WINTER OPEN (RESTRICTED) HERITAGE M&M MIXED HEIGHT WHP**. Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, Registered Pure Bred ponies. Riders any age. In a mixed height class, riders may ride more than one animal providing they are of different heights. Animals must jump in their correct height section. **Large height will jump first.** **(Riders on Restricted animals MUST wear an armband)**

This class will be split if there are sufficient entries

HERITAGE M&M WHP CHAMPIONSHIP

open to the 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 7, 8 & 9

HORSE WORKERCLASSES

Not before 2.30pm



(deliberately NOT titled Working “Hunter”, these classes are open to any type of horse; hunter, hack, riding horse, cob (hogged or “hairy”), Arabs etc and will be judged on ride, conformation and movement and not type)

All the Horse classes will be judged on a similar format as the ponies ... each horse will jump in front of the first judge and then move to the other part of the ring to be assessed for ride and conformation by the second judge.

There will be no group “go round”

Class 10 **Nursery Novice Horse Worker.** Open to horses 4 years old and over, exceeding 14hh (143cm) Riders ANY AGE. Height of fences will not exceed 2’

Class 11 **“New Combination” Horse Worker.** Open to horses 4 years old and over, exceeding 14hh (143cm) Riders ANY AGE, Rider/Horse combination not to have competed in a Worker class together prior to 1st January in the current year. Height of fences will not exceed 2’3”

Class 12 **Novice Horse Worker.** Open to horses 4 years old and over, exceeding 14hh (143cm) Riders ANY AGE. Height of fences will not exceed 2’ 6”

Class 13 **Small Open Horse Worker.** Open to horses 4 years old and over, exceeding 14hh (143cm) Riders ANY AGE. Height of fences approx 3’

Class 14 **Open Horse Worker.** Open to horses 4 years old and over, exceeding 14hh (143cm) Riders ANY AGE. Height of fences approx 3’6”

**WORKING HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP – open to the 1st & 2nd prizewinners
from classes 10 to 14**

There is no Supreme Championship this year, instead we have introduced a “Plaited” WHP Championship and a Heritage M&M Championship, so that ponies can home rather than waiting until very late

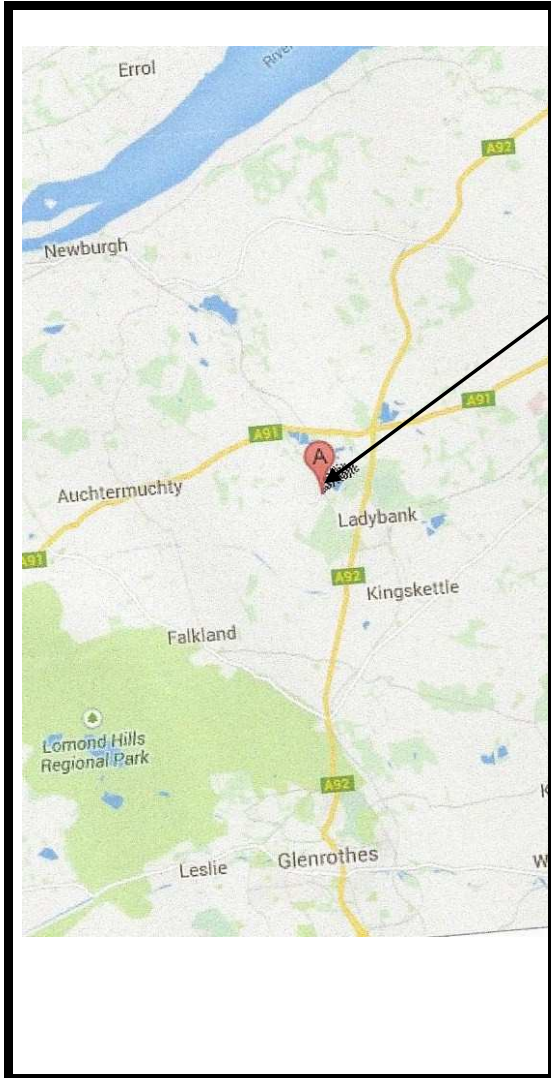

Highfield @ Howe

Arnot Acres

From the South/Forth Bridge Exit the M90 at Junction 2A and follow the the A92 taking a left fork onto the B937 a mile or so north of Freuchie, signposted Giffordtown. Highfield @ Howe is a couple of miles on the left, or From the South, West/Forth Bridge/Kincardine Bridge Exit the M90 at Junction 8 (this junction has a northbound exit only) onto the A91 and travel through Gateside and Auchtermuchty and turn right onto the B937 signposted to Giffordtown. Highfield @ Howe is a mile on the right.

From the North/Tay Bridge Follow the A92 south to the Melville Lodges roundabout and turn right onto the A91, after just over a mile turn left onto the B937 signposted to Giffordtown. Highfield @ Howe is a mile on the right.

Highfield @ Howe has a large Indoor Arena which will be split for the pony classes to enable 2 judges to judge the jumping and way of going/conformation within the same arena. This may mean entering/exiting at different sides of the arena building. We are also spoiled to have an indoor warm up arena, and indoor holding/collecting area. We hope these will be self policed, so ask all competitors to respect others if these areas become busy.

Hot Food and Drinks will be available at the centre cafeteria throughout the day
