This is an unaffiliated show with the benefits of a BS course builder and judge, Club Members of BS can gather Club points, and all other riders compete for rosettes as with unaffiliated.

It is open to all with the added bonus of horses and ponies placed separately in each class.

Classes start with Clear Rounds at 55cm and 65cm. Competitions at 70cm, 80cm, 90cm and 1m for all.

1.10m offered to Schools League Class and as a Clear Round at the end for anyone wishing to take part.

Also running will be qualifiers for British Showjumping National Schools Championships

In conjunction with The Pony Club, British Showjumping have joined forces with schools across the country to launch a National Schools Team & Individual Championship series.

Show venues have already started committing themselves to the Championships with all regions having booked **British Showjumping – just for schools** show dates in their competition calendar for 2016.

This exciting new Championships will allow for schools and colleges to submit teams of three or four riders and individuals within a specific height category of either 70cm, 80cm, 90cm, 1.00m or 1.10m.

A league table underpins each of the height categories with an objective of qualifying for the National Schools Team and Individual Championship Finals which will take place at the British Showjumping National Championships at Stoneleigh Park next summer.

The ten Championship Finals (five team and five individuals) will take place at the British Showjumping National Championships at Stoneleigh Park next summer. There are two routes to qualifying for the Final; either by being within the top eight of the **British Showjumping – just for schools** team league, top ten of the individual league table or via one of two direct qualifiers.

Eligibility couldn't be easier making the Championships accessible to all. Schools can register their team of three or four riders for just £30 per year. For riders who wish to compete as an Individual outside of the teams, as long as they are a member of British Showjumping or The Pony Club already there is no need to pay another registration fee. If not a member of either, then they can join directly with British Showjumping for just £30 which covers both themselves and their horse/pony for a full 12 months.

There is a Schools League and Championship in conjunction with The Pony Club which currently runs from January 2016 to the end of June 2016.

Schools/Colleges can submit teams of three or four riders within a specific height category of 70 cm, 80cm, 90cm, 1.00m and 1.10m at "Just for Schools" competitions.

Each competition will generate points for the teams and individuals that go towards the national Schools League for each height. These leagues then provide the platform for top 8 teams and 10 individuals to qualify for the British Showjumping National Championships at Stoneleigh Park in August 2016.

Along with league qualifications there will also be four direct qualifiers in the North, South, East and West where the winning team and top three individuals will qualify for the Final.

2016 will see the leagues run from January – June and thereafter running from the 1st July until the 30th June each year.

For a School/College team to join it is just £30 for the year for three or four members, these members can be interchanged throughout the year as long as we are provided with the riders details. Along with each team application form please submit an individual application form for each horse/rider as well.

If a School has individuals that want to compete they can and if they are members of either The Pony Club or British Showjumping they do not need to pay another registration fee, if they are not a member of either there is a £30 registration fee for the year for the horse and rider combination.
